



Travelling by Rail

National Rail Enquiry Line: 08457 48 49 50

Falkirk High Station is on the main Glasgow - Edinburgh line with a 15 minute service between 07:30 and 18:30 (every 30 minutes outwith these times). There is no direct bus from Falkirk High station to the Business Park. A number 18 bus service will drop you outside Asda in Newmarket Street Falkirk. From here you will need to change buses: a number 1 or 2 (every 10 minutes), or a number 38, (every 30 minutes), will take 10 minutes and drop you off outside the Business Park on Callendar Road. Cross the road and walk up Callendar Boulevard, turn first right then left at the mini roundabout - our building is the first building on the right after the road sweeps round to the right. Alternatively, a taxi from the High Station will cost approximately £3.00.

From Falkirk Grahamston station you will be able to catch a direct bus from Park Street outside the station. Leave the station by the ramp alongside the Royal Mail building and cross the road. The stop is a short distance away, past the roundabout. A number 1 or 2 (every 10 minutes), or a number 38, (every 30 minutes), will take 10 minutes and drop you off outside the Business Park on Callendar Road. Cross the road and walk up Callendar Boulevard, turn first right then left at the mini roundabout - our building is the first building on the right after the road sweeps round to the right. Alternatively, a taxi from Falkirk Grahamston will cost approximately £3.50.

Travelling by Car

Approx. 14 miles from Stirling, 25 miles from Edinburgh and 25 miles from Glasgow

From Stirling/the North

Travelling south on the M9, leave at J6 Grangemouth and turn right onto the A905, Glensburgh Road. Turn right on the Earls Gate Roundabout onto the A904 for Falkirk. Turn left at the Westfield roundabout (to go in front of the new Falkirk Community Stadium) up to the Bog roundabout. Continue straight over the roundabout in the direction of Laurieston then turn right at the next roundabout to go under the railway bridge. At the next roundabout turn left into Callendar Business Park. Once in the Business Park take first right in front of Hadrian House and then left at the mini roundabout. The road sweeps round to the right, the CVS and Volunteer Centre is in the building on the right - we're on the first floor (the logos are on the windows so we're easy to spot!).

From Edinburgh/the East

Leave the M9 at Junction 5 and take the first left at the roundabout at the foot of the slip road onto the A9 and continue for approx. 1.5 miles. Go left at the Bog roundabout, turn right at the next roundabout to go under the railway bridge. At the next roundabout turn left into Callendar Business Park. Once in the Business Park take first right in front of Hadrian House and then left at the mini roundabout. The road sweeps round to the right, the CVS and Volunteer Centre is in the building on the right - we're on the first floor (the logos are on the windows so we're easy to spot!).

From Glasgow/the West

Leave the M8 heading eastbound at J13 onto the M80 for Stirling and follow this until Junction 5 (M876), signposted Kincardine Bridge. Merge with the M9 to Edinburgh and leave at Junction 5 (Grangemouth/Bo'ness) and turn right at the traffic lights. At the roundabout take the A9 Falkirk exit onto Beancross Road. Go left at the Bog roundabout, turn right at the next roundabout to go under the railway bridge. At the next roundabout turn left into Callendar Business Park. Once in the Business Park take first right in front of Hadrian House and then left at the mini roundabout. The road sweeps round to the right, the CVS and Volunteer Centre is in the building on the right - we're on the first floor (the logos are on the windows so we're easy to spot!).



Parking

Unfortunately there are no designated spaces for visitors to the CVS and Volunteer Centre other than disabled bays. The Business Park has a fair amount of parking spaces not all of which are occupied. You may have to park at the roadside. Parking in the area is free.



Landmarks

Coming from Falkirk town centre, Callendar Business Park is situated to the east (far side) of Callendar House and Park, just past the relatively new Graeme High School - after passing the school go right at the roundabout to enter the Business Park. Coming from the Grangemouth/Laurieston end the Business Park is sign posted and you'll pass the large Benny T's chip shop just before going under the railway bridge. Turn left at the roundabout just past the railway bridge to enter the Business Park.
